Upon completing his training and becoming board certified in Obstetrics and Gynecology (Facharzt), Dr. Okoye returned to Nigeria. He worked briefly at Bishop Shanahan Hospital, Nsukka, as a Consultant Obstetrician and Gynecologist.

He subsequently relocated to the United States, where he completed a three-year residency in Internal Medicine. He is board certified and licensed to practice medicine in the United States.

Dr. Okoye worked for many years as a physician with major hospitals in South Carolina and North Carolina, where he was responsible for the management of hospitalized patients. He later established his own outpatient medical practice, Eastway Medical Clinic and Urgent Care, in Charlotte, North Carolina, which he manages with his wife, Dr. Sylvia I. Okoye, an internist.

Dr. Joseph Okoye resides in Charlotte, North Carolina, with his wife and their five children.
